The 1st Marine Division Association (FMDA) was formed on August 7, 1947, the anniversary of the Guadalcanal landing, by veterans who campaigned under the battle colors of the 1st Marine Division, the most decorated military unit in American history.

The primary mission of the FMDA is its Scholarship Program for dependents of honorably discharged veterans, now deceased from any cause or totally and permanently disabled, who served in the 1st Marine Division. The scholarship program is supported entirely by voluntary donations from Association members. Since the start of the program, some 522 students have received over \$1.5 million in tuition assistance.
